Psychosocial impact category in treatment as a system of means of medical deontology

The results of the theoretical analyses of a phenomenon of "psychosocial impact", its systematization and conceptual mechanism are analyzed in the article. Specific features of treatment interaction in the system "medical person - patient" are analyzed.

Aims, principles and functions of therapeutic environment are described; the influence of relations forming process among medical stuff on the psychological climate is viewed. As a result of this research, the following conclusions can be made:

1) psychosocial impact is the key category in psychology because the issues connected with the mental evolution and the control over the mental phenomenon are the most concentrated in it.

2) in deontological culture the psychosocial impact on the other person's mental condition, thoughts, feelings and actions is accomplished with the help of psychological means.

3) weighty factors of forming an effective treatment interaction in the system "medical person - patient" are communicative competence, the selected type of communication of both sides, medical person's empathic ability, his professional maturity and the positive psychological climate among medical stuff. Psychological basic foundation of deontology consists of the above mentioned elements.
