### **Psychological problems of poverty in Ukraine XXI century**

In the article the problems of severe social and psychological burden on the wider Ukrainian society, which caused rapid process of impoverishment and poverty, are studied.

This work is acute due to the fact that the way of independent Ukraine towards becoming a truly democratic European state is extremely delayed. This situation has caused serious socio-psychological problem that is to theoretically ensure coordination of public efforts and resources to fight poverty in Ukraine. However, these significant social issues are always considered by economists, financiers, sociologists and political scientists. Unfortunately, their study has not given significant results. Therefore, the author proposes to examine these processes in the light of psychology.

Theoretical analysis of scientific sources and comparison of it with the official conclusions of the socio-economic situation in Ukraine are the main psychological negative achievements of civil society. These include:

1. World experience shows that the economic problems can not be solved by a principle;
2. Ukraine, as a state, continues to exist solely because of ethnic and cultural heritage, history of the native population that are called mentality;
3. The citizens of Ukraine have to live in a nervous state, internal conflict society which makes them feel politically and socially passive, experience social and criminal infantilism. Moreover, it generates inability to solve the acute social problems of their life together.

It is recommended to determine the creation of a positive option to solve psychological problems of impoverishment.

While revealing the poverty issues, it should be noted that this material is not comprehensive. Therefore, the work in this area should not dwell, as long as the

society will suffer until those problems and socio-psychological order tracking of these extremely painful social processes are taken into account.
